Subject Faculty Tenure Review Procedures - Full Professor		Effective 11/19/89 Revised 8/92

PURPOSE: To Define Criteria for Promotion to Full Professor

SOURCES: School of Social Work Faculty Council

APPLICABILITY: All Faculty, School of Social Work

POLICY: Promotion to Full Professor

- A. For promotion to Professor or tenure at that rank, a high degree of excellence should be shown with respect to all of the criteria areas.
- B. The faculty member should be rated as a recognized senior person both within the School and within the field, and represent a person the School would select for a Full Professor position if it were open to national competition.
- C. For a person to be judged a prospective professor, it should be agreed that excellence has already been demonstrated by outstanding achievement and is not a question of potential or future probability.
- D. An individual's cumulative record since promotion to Associate Professor will be used in the determination of promotion to Full Professor.
