APPLICATION PROCEDURES**

All applicants must submit an application to the Certificate Program to the School of Social Work **and** apply to the Graduate College. Applications are accepted throughout the year.

NOTE: You may take six credit hours prior to submitting an application to the certificate program.

The following items must be submitted directly to the ASU Graduate College

- On line certificate application. Apply electronically at www.asu.edu/graduate
- Application Fee
- An official transcript from the institution that granted your bachelors degree. **Note:** If you received your baccalaureate degree from ASU you do not need to submit an official transcript

The following items are submitted directly to the School of Social Work, Office of Academic Services:

- School of Social Work application to the Assessment of Integrative Health Modalities Certificate program. The application is available at the following website:

- Resume or Curriculum Vitae
- A one to two page, double spaced statement describing how you will use the knowledge gained in this certificate program in your professional and or personal life
