

## **Advanced Direct Practice – Elective Requirements**

Students in the Children, Youth and Family Specialization or the Health/Behavioral Health With Adults Specialization may take one social work elective of their choice or may petition to take an elective in another graduate discipline. The other two electives must be from the approved list of electives for Advanced Direct Practice.

Students in the Public Child Welfare specialization are required to take SWG 633 Child Welfare Services as one of their three electives. The other two electives must be approved by the Child Welfare Training Project.
